

# Perfect Placemats



Turn leftover fabric into the festive feature of your holiday dinner party. Hand-created placemats provide an eye-catching setting and serve as a colorful background to your perfectly prepared meal. You'll surprise your friends and family when you tell them they took just minutes to create, for just a few dollars!



## You Will Need:

From Savers/Value Village

- Large woven fabric remnant in a square weave (woven wool plaid, linen or linen-blends work best); curtains or tablecloths can work well

Other supplies

- Scissors

## Directions:

- 1) Cut fabric into appx. 15"x17" squares to create as many placemats as you would like.
- 2) Instead of sewing the edges, gently pull out the threads that run parallel to the cut edges, one at a time. Leave behind the long threads as "fringe," measuring appx. 1"-1½".
- 3) Set on the table and enjoy!
