

BATTY PHOTO BACKDROP

Bust out your old Polaroid for retro charm, or take digital snaps and send them around after the witching hour winds down. Seeing fun memories of the evening will make your guests howl in delight.



You Will Need:

From Savers/Value Village

- White sheet
- Vintage Polaroid camera (typically found in the jewelry/special case section; if not a Polaroid, grab your digital camera)

Other supplies

- Bat clip art of your choice
- Printer
- Construction paper or lightweight cardboard for bat stencil
- Pencil
- Double-sided tape
- Black matte spray paint
- Polaroid film (optional; available online)

Directions:

- 1) To create your stencil, print out bat clip art and cut around the bat. Place the bat onto the construction paper or lightweight cardboard and trace around it. Cut out the inside of the bat.
- 2) Wash and dry the white sheet, then lay it out in a large flat area that is well ventilated.
- 3) Using your bat stencil and black spray paint, randomly spray paint bats onto the sheet spaced close together. Be careful to ensure the paint is dry when placing the stencil in a nearby area, so as not to smear other bats. Using the double-sided tape on the stencil will help hold it in place as you go.
- 4) Allow backdrop to dry completely.
- 5) Hang the sheet in your desired location and snap away!
